Please complete the electronic consent form using the link below before 15 October 2024. (one for each child) to ensure your child receives their vaccination.






Year 3 Work Hard in Maths

Year 4 Explore Newspaper Reports

This week in reading lessons, Year 4 have been exploring the features of newspaper reports. Children were given sections of an unseen report and were tasked to restructure it using their knowledge of key features. The class worked in teams to piece together the newspaper and they all understood that newspapers start with a headline and use sub-headings to group sections of information. The children were also tasked with writing their own headlines for different events. They came up with brilliant, eye-catching headlines to grab their readers' attention!







Year 5 'Being in my World'

Year 5 have been enjoying there topic in PSHE 'Being in my World'. This week we have been looking at rewards and consequences and looking at why we think it is a good idea to have them. We also came up with ideas on different rewards and consequences we should have both in school and out of school.



Year 6 Enjoy their Science Lessons

In science this week, year 6 have been learning about the different components of our blood. We learned that our blood contains red blood cells, white blood cells, platelets and plasma and we looked at the role of each of these. To demonstrate this, we then created our own blood using cheerios to represent our red blood cells, marshmallows to represent our white blood cells, sprinkles to represent our platelets and yellow-dyed water to represent our plasma.
