Reception Go On Safari

This week Reception went on safari! We got strapped into our Sacriston Star jeep, got our binoculars at the ready and set off on our journey. We spotted lots of safari animals and we drew the animals we saw along the way. Have a look at our Reception children's fantastic drawings! We had so much fun and talked about what the different animals look like, what they were doing and how they were moving. We recognised that:

"Giraffes have long necks and spotted skin."

"The lions are in their pride under the tree."

"The zebra has black and white stripes."



Year 1 Look at the History of Our School

This week Year 1 began the new topic, Schools by looking at the history of our school! The class looked at previous images from the school exploring how the school has changed in the last 30 years. This included learning how the school was originally separated into two separate schools with their own headteachers. They also looked for signs of history around school, including signs from the school's opening in 1910.







Year 2 Explore 3D Shapes!

Year 2 have been learning all about 3D shapes in their maths lessons this week. We explored faces, sides, vertices and nets, as well as making patterns using these shapes. The children were able to develop their knowledge by assembling their own nets of 3D shapes.







Year 3 Make their Own Lanterns!

This week in Year 3 we have been working very hard and learning about fractions. All the class have shown great resilience and have produced some great work at the start of this topic. In RE this week, we learned all about Vesak and the Festival of Light in our Buddhism topic. We got creative and made our own lanterns! Well done Year 3!





Year 4 'Living Things and their Habitats'

Year 4 have started their new topic 'Living Things and their Habitats' in Science. As part of this, we discussed what living things we typically see in our local area. We then went and explored our school grounds to see what we could find. As a class we found lots of minibeasts as well as different types of trees and plants. We then discussed the key features different living things have and why they are important. We were shocked to discover that a woodlouse has 14 legs and a spider has 6 eyes! We thought carefully about how these features can help living things within their habitats.



Year 5 Trip to Broom House Farm

This week, Year 5 have travelled to Broom House Farm as part of their Sow, Grow and Farm topic. Here, the children got to meet lots of different animals including sheep, chickens, goats and pigs. It was an amazing experience being so close to them and getting to interact with them. In the afternoon, the children were able to complete some team-building activities in the Forest Adventure centre. What an amazing day!
