Early Years Animal Antics Stay and Play

Nursery and Reception loved sharing their learning this morning with friends and family. The children created so many colourful pieces of art. The children created fluffy, feathered parrots and collage animals with tissue paper. The children searched for animals around our learning environment with their beautiful animal print binoculars.



Year 1 Make 'Unicorn' Play Dough!

In Year 1 we have been practicing our instruction writing skills all about how to make 'unicorn' play dough! The class learned about how to make the dough and wrote instructions using key features including an equipment list and using imperative verbs. Then, the class followed their own instructions to create their own unicorn dough using conditioner, cornflour and glitter.



Year 2 Conduct their Own Experiment

Year 2 have been learning all about plants in their Science lessons this half term. We conducted our very own experiment and planted bean seeds in pots! Children were able to use the knowledge they have learned so far to use compost, seeds, pots, water and light to plant our seeds. We are going to observe how germination takes place and monitor the progress of our bean plants over the coming weeks.



Year 3 Learn About Roman Life!

Year 3 have been learning about Roman life this week including how to be a Roman Emperor, what the Romans have done for us and what Roman art was like. We have looked at different pieces of artwork and mosaic art. We have enjoyed looking at how the pictures were made from small pieces of coloured clay and placed in intricate patterns. During our Art lessons we have created our own mosaic art pictures.



Year 4 'Statues, Statuettes and Figurines'

This week, Year 4 have been exploring their art topic: Statues, statuettes and figurines. We started off by looking at famous statues from around the world and sketched some of our favourites including the Statue of Liberty and Christ the Redeemer. We then explored sculptures from ancient civilisations and what figurines have been found in Egyptian tombs! We sketched some of these discoveries before creating our own Egyptian sculptures using clay! We had so much fun and used different techniques to add detail to our sculptures. Well done Year 4.



Year 5 Learn All about Life Cycles

Year 5 have been working extra hard in their Science lessons this week! We have learnt all about life cycles and have explored how the life cycle of a plant is different to the life cycle of animal. Well done year 5!



Year 6 Design their Own Bridges!

In DT, Year 6 have been learning about the structure of different types of bridges. As part of this they have enjoyed working in teams to design and then make their own bridges, seeing which bridge could hold the most weight. It seems we have some engineers in the making!
