We have been reading "The Incredible Journey" this week. The children were very excited to design their own pirate hats so that they could be like the fierce pirate in the book. They have also astounded us all with their use of the Wondrous Words this week, such as 'incredible', 'fierce' and 'slimy.'









YEAR 1

Year 1 have been retelling the story 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff' in their writing this week. They have enjoyed verbally retelling the story, particularly recalling the words spoken by the troll! The children have then been writing sentences to retell the story. As a challenge some children also continued the story using their own ideas about what happened to the troll after he was pushed off the bridge.



YEAR 2

Year 2 have been thoroughly enjoying their new art topic "Still Life". We learned all about this style and format of creating pieces of artwork and observed in our very own classroom 'art gallery' some famous pieces of artwork by famous artists. We used artistic vocabulary to comment on these, comparing and contrasting. The class were then able to attempt their own still life drawing using an existing example.





YEAR 3

This week, Year 3 have been looking at the impact of the Iron Age on Britain. The name 'Iron Age' derives from the switch from bronze to iron courtesy of the Celts. With this came new jobs such as being a blacksmith and iron was seen as a lot stronger than bronze, making fantastic weapons. After a discussion around this, the children were given questions to answer in their books to consolidate their knowledge.

We thought about the things we like about ourselves and our personalities and what we like about our peers.
