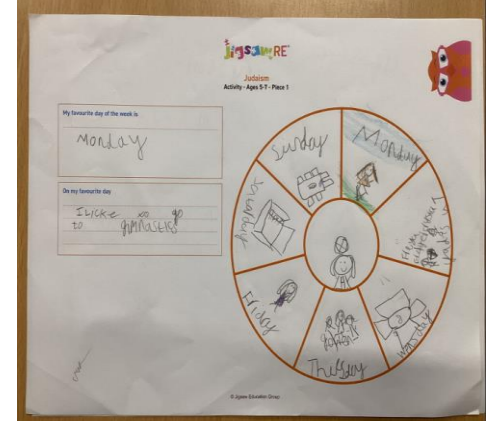
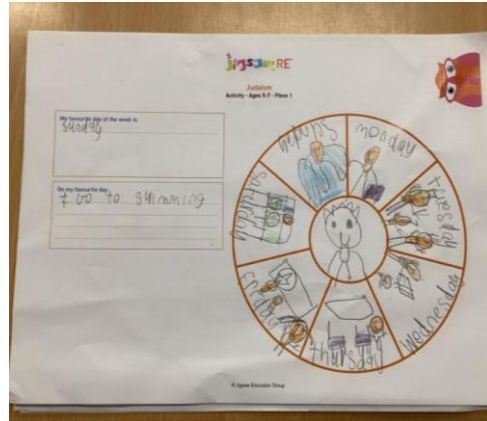
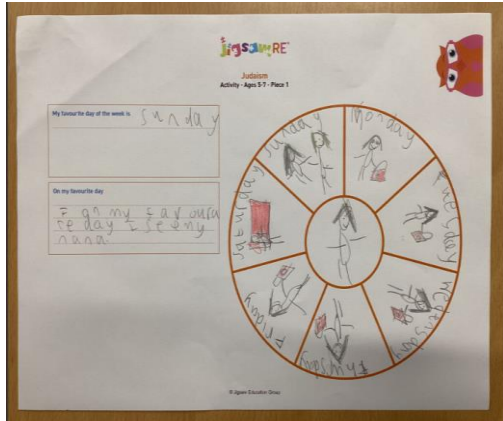
## **Year 1 Learn All about Forgiveness**

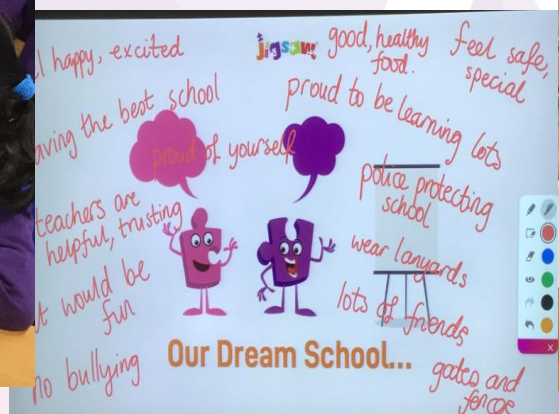
## Year 2 Enjoy their RE Lessons

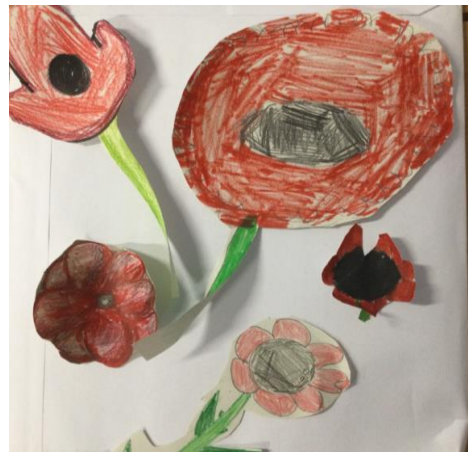
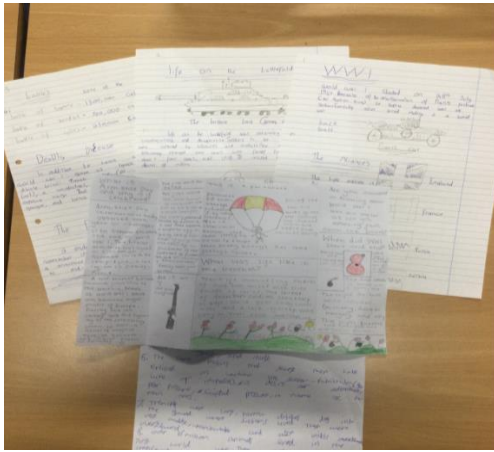
### **Year 5 Enjoy their French Lessons**

Our Headteacher Awards were presented today to **Year 2** in KS1 and **Year 4** in KS2 the following children who have all impressed their class teacher:

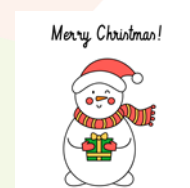
